**L**orenz, the son of Martin Sklorz and Hedwig Kulik, was born and baptized in Staniszcze Wielkie. In 1836 he married Susanna, the daughter of Christian / Chrystoph Manka and Marianna Czok, who was from the same village. After almost thirteen years together sharing both joys and sorrows, Lorenz and their children endured the loss of Susanna who died when she was only 33 years of age.

In 1855 Lorenz and his children sailed on the *Isaac Wright* and arrived in New York in May. They travelled on to Texas and settled in Karnes County. By 1859 Lorenz owned seven cattle valued at \$42, and oxen and hogs worth \$49 (Karnes County Tax Assessments, 1859, 13<sup>th</sup> page).

One year later, Lorenz and his children relocated to Goliad County. In 1861 he purchased approximately 52 acres on the south side of Hoosier Creek for \$157.17 (Goliad County Deed Records, Volume J1, pp. 239-240). The last known official documentation for Lorenz appears in the 1869 Goliad tax records.
