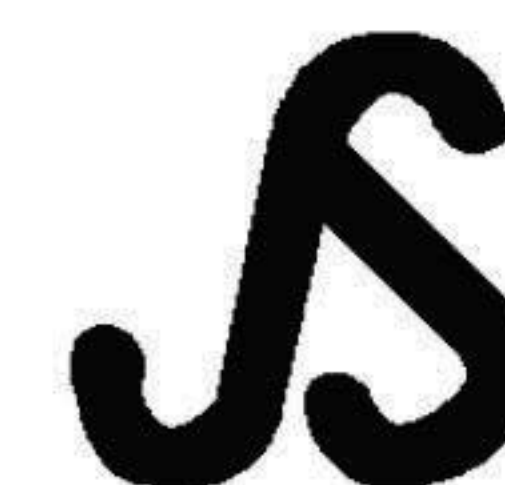

Wojciech Stanuś was the son of Thomas Stanuś and Josepha Wrzeciono. Maria Burda was the daughter of Franz Burda and Catharina Jendrysik and the granddaughter of Paul Jendrysik, as shown in the baptism record below. Maria's baptism did not specify the date of birth; only her baptism date was noted in the margin. In that period of time when Silesia was part of Prussia, priests recorded baptisms in German which was the official language.

Both Wojciech and Maria were baptized and married in Św. Mikołaja in Świbie, written as Schwieben in German. They had two children who were baptized in the same parish. Tragically their infant son Paul died in 1844, and only two months later, Wojciech endured the death of his wife Maria. Wojciech was left with their three-year-old daughter Josefa and soon remarried (see next page of of this profile).

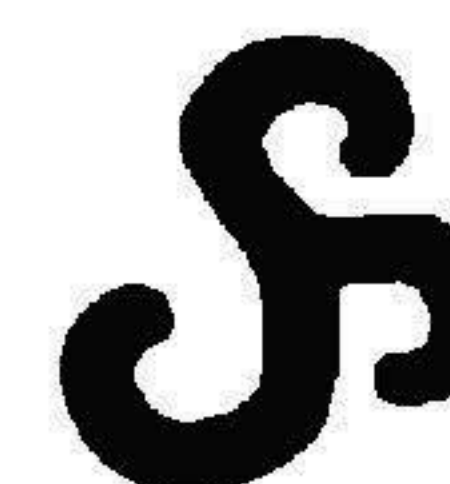

After the death of his first wife, Wojciech Stanuś married Cecilia, the daughter of Augustin Badura and Susanna Płaczek. In 1855 they immigrated to Texas with five children and settled in St. Hedwig. Wojciech registered his cattle brand at the Bexar County Courthouse in 1857, and by 1862 owned five acres of land valued at \$20 (Bexar County Tax Assessment, 1862, p. 73, entry #93).

In 1870 the Stanuś family owned 300 acres of land valued at \$1,200. Their livestock valued at \$900 included 10 horses, 2 mules, 30 milk cows, 100 other cattle, 10 oxen, 20 sheep, and 20 swine. In addition, they had 300 bushels of Indian corn, 20 bushels of sweet potatoes, and 150 pounds of butter (U.S. Agricultural Census, Wilson County, 1870, second page, line 11).
