

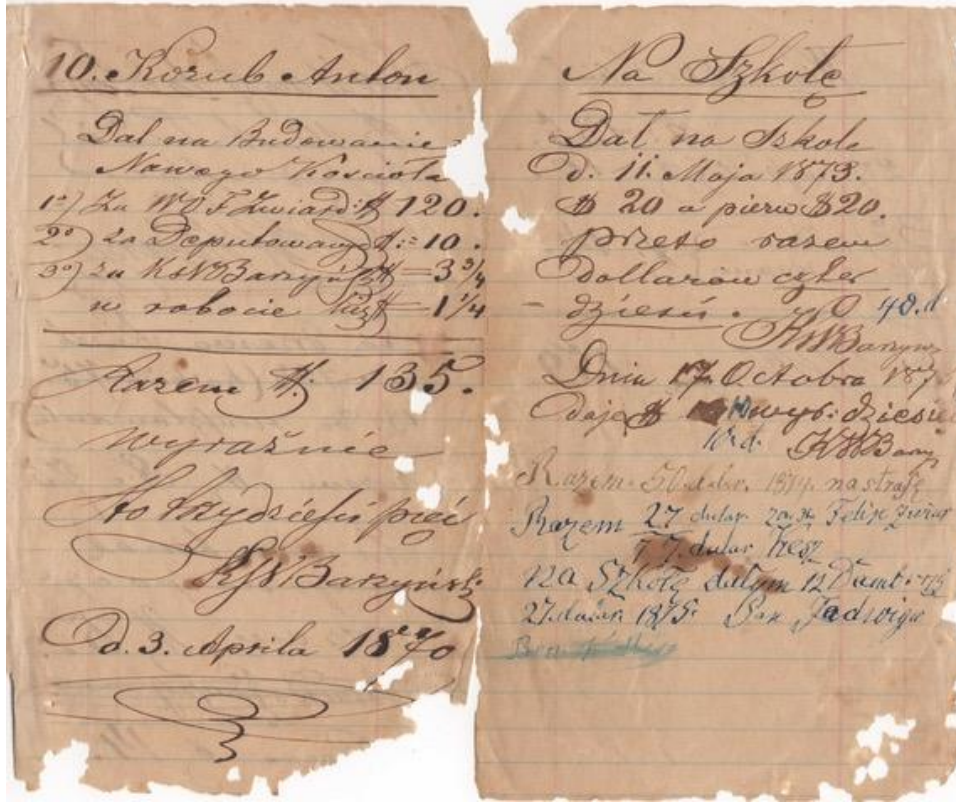
**Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Catholic Church, St. Hedwig,
Texas – Building Receipt to Anton Kozub**

These receipts were given to Allen & Regina Kosub by his Aunt Emmy Kosub, who is the granddaughter of Anton Kozub. Anton Kozub was the elected deputy for the building of the church, school, and cemetery.

[Below are] two documents related to the building of St. Hedwig's 1868 rock church. Rev. Barzynski was required to provide a receipt to each donor for their contribution of money, materials, or labor before the church was conveyed to the Bishop. This is **a copy of the receipt provided to Anton Kozub for his contributions**. It is the only copy of such receipt known to exist.

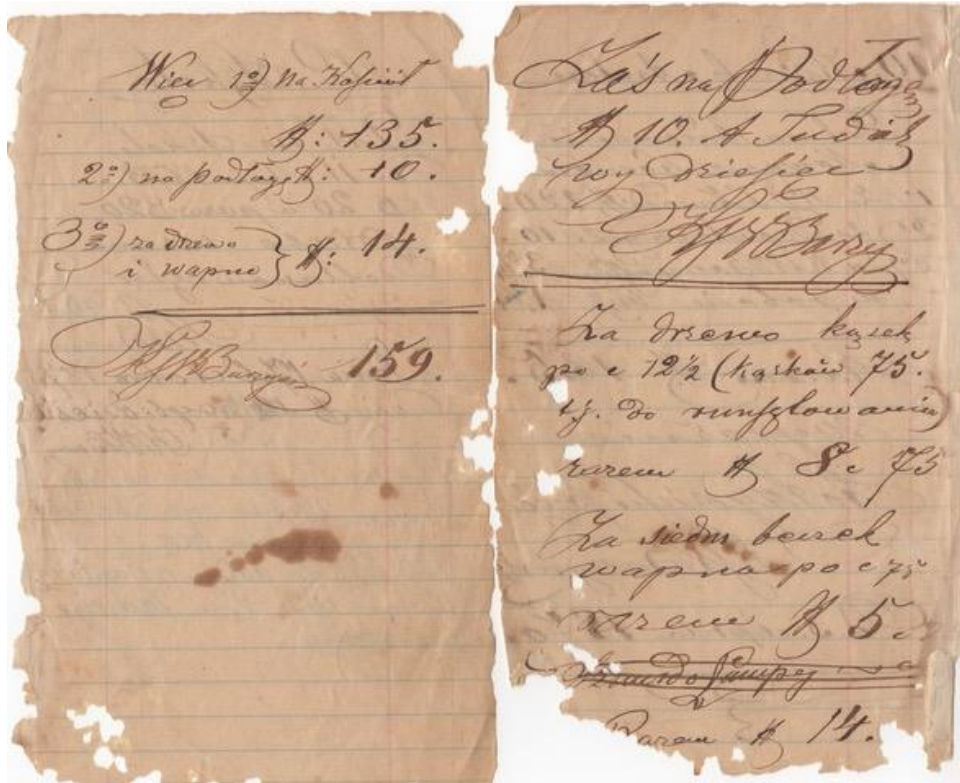
